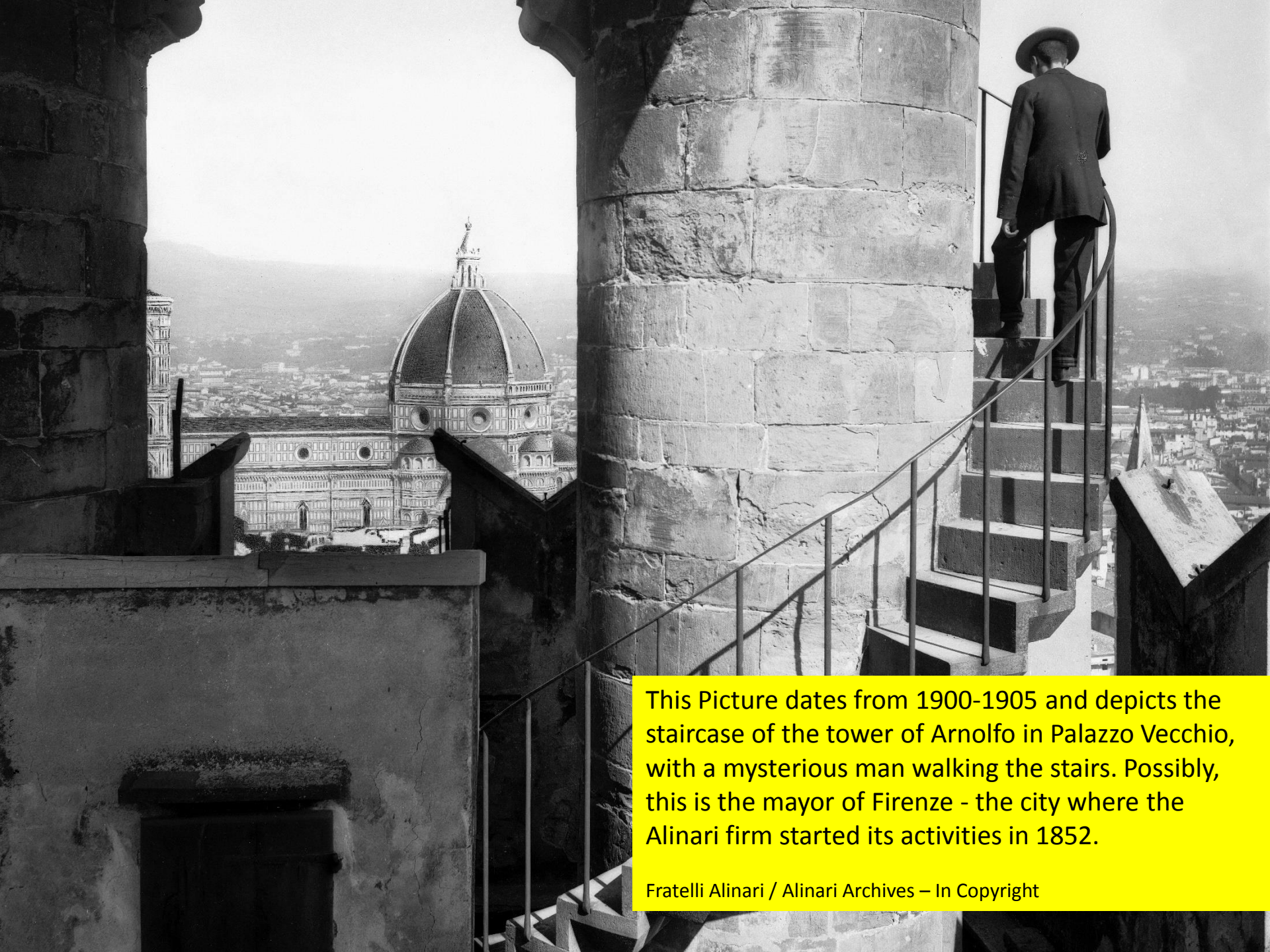

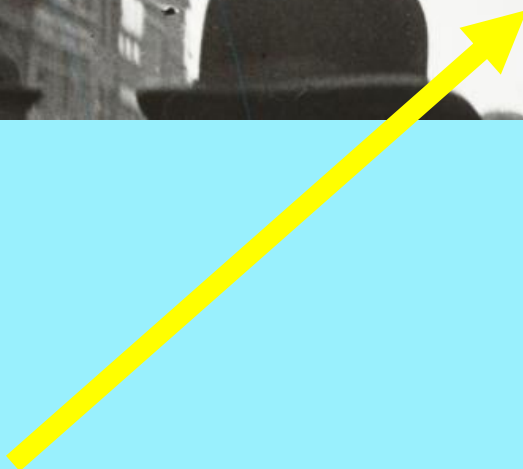

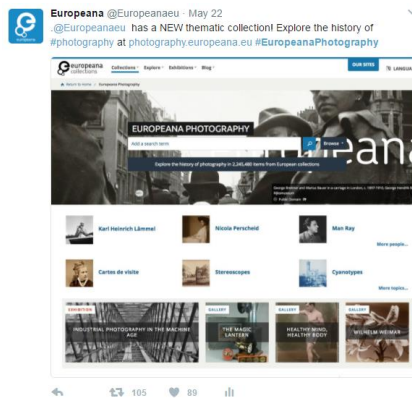

Milhares de museus e galerias de arte da Europa vêm dedicando os últimos anos a digitalizar seus acervos. Uma plataforma online chamada Europeana reúne mais de 50 milhões de obras de 3300 entidades, e uma das coleções é capaz de revelar partes da história que você provavelmente não conhecia.

A Europeana é atualizada constantemente e seus curadores costumam organizar coleções temáticas bem interessantes, como uma sobre um **genocídio esquecido por Leonardo Da Vinci**, estes antigos cartões postais do **Leste Europeu** e uma galeria que mostra como a **selva natural do continente** inspirou artistas durante vários séculos.

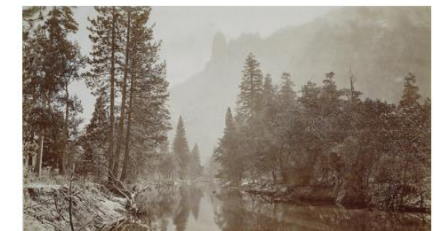
