








Thematic Collections > why?

 - a) a superior user experience
 - b) higher value to content providers
- Increase audience by aligning collection themes with existing communities of interest
- Show that Europeana is not just
 another search engine > impossible

- Build partnerships within and beyond our network









Linked Open Data is a way of publishing structured data that allows metadata to be connected and enriched and links made between related resources.


