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Expected outputs - technical

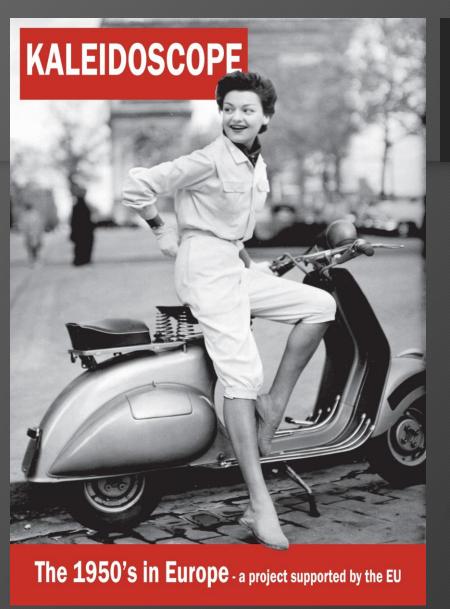
- Visual similarity search tool and related demo applications such as augmented reality app, to improve user's search and interaction with Europeana content

- A virtual exhibition to be published in Europeana Photography + a physical travelling exhibition about lifetime in the 50s
