

WHAT IS EUROPEANA ?

We transform the world with culture! We want to build on Europe's rich heritage and make it easier for people to use, whether for work, for learning or just for fun.

- an **open online database**, centralising all metadata and content related to cultural heritage objects available across Europe
- a **search engine** to explore these collections
- a set of **thematic channels** limited to the best **quality/most relevant items**
- several **Web services** available that can be used by developers, creatives and researchers

 - Moteur Collections
- **Domain** aggregators
 - => for Photography : Photoconsortium
 - => for Audiovisual archives : European Film Gateway

- You can directly register as a Provider there
- You will liaise directly with us to publish/update your data

The CMS route

- Omeka based CMS
- **Designed by/for the GLAM community**
- Storage offers
- Batch upload of records
- Customisable frontend
- **Automated publishing to Europeana**

Tools

UI approach

- **Open Refine (Free)**
 - => Cleaning / Separating / Matching values
 - => Transforming from 1 format to another
 - => etc.
- **MINT (License)**
 - => GUI based mapping tool
 - => Consistent tool but not dedicated to advanced mappings

Tools

Code approach

XSLT transformations + Oxygen (Licence)

- => The same, but more powerful
- => One of the best 'All XML' combo for advanced users







METADATA

- Persistent & Unique identifiers
- Resources from **Controlled Vocabularies**
=> Photocons., Wikidata, Getty ATT & ULAN
- **Language** attributes (2 letters code)
- Informational **relevance**
=> e.g. a dimension is not a type
- EDM records

Data & Good practices



CONTENT

- 400px min. for thumbnails
- 800px min. for main representations
- No watermarks
- IIIF framework
- **Open licences please !**
