Activities in the **DSI-4** are about:

We are currently negotiating the prosecution of the DSI until August 2022. We foresee a slight shift from pure metadata improving activity to 'capacity building' (e.g. education, training and dissemination).




EUROPEANA DSI-4

- Kaleidoscope 50s in Europe started on 1 September 2018 and lasted until 29 February 2020.
- Partners: KU Leuven, Photoconsortium, CRDI, Topfoto, SPK, OSZK, KIK-IRPA, NTUA, IMEC, COVUNI
- We involved also two other members of the association:
 United Archives and Museovirasto
- The validation meeting took place on 26/5/2020 with successful results and the procedure is almost closed



Over **18,000 new records** aggregated to Europeana + a successful **annotation** campaign also supported with automatically generated metadata (over 8,000 annotations)

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

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


