EUROPEANA DSI-4


To comply with the tasks of DSI-4, Photoconsortium involves personnel and members for specific activities.

Kaleidoscope 50s in Europe 3 main outcomes

- It is a technological project that uses deep learning techniques for visual recognition, to experiment automatic enrichment of metadata of digital collections.
- It has a strong education focus and will produce, among other outcomes, a MOOC.
- A physical exhibition will premiere in Pisa on the 6th of September.






DISSEMINATION ACTIVITIES during 2018
