

DSI-4 is a 4 years project: started in September 2019, concludes 31 August 2022

Activities in the **DSI-4** concern:

- Content/Metadata Tier improvement of existing datasets
- Participation in Europeana meetings and task forces
- Overall networking with other aggregators

Next to the project activities, participation in the DSI includes:

- Participation in various Europeana taskforces and communities: data quality, copyright community, education, climate, diversity and inclusion
- Participation in surveys and actions such as the CHIs satisfaction questionnaire and the dissemination of the Impact Playbook
- Administration and bi-monthly reporting
- Participation in Europeana Aggregators Forum, Europeana Conference and since 2021
 Europeana Aggregators Fair





Work performed in DSI4



- Metadata cleaning, correction of broken links
- Aggregation of new collections and seeking for new data partners
- Two case studies about the advantages of sharing reusable content, based on the experiences of KU Leuven and CRDI
- Capacity building workshops (at Euromed 2020 and Digital Past 2021) and a 3-parts event organized together with EUROCLIO focused on educational reuse of collections
- Crowdsourcing annotations campaigns (in collaboration with Citizen Heritage project)
- Newsletters and blogs to highlight benefits of participating in Europeana and in Europeana-related projects

The DSI4 actions will hopefully be prosecuted from September onwards following the results of the DEP tender "European Data Space for cultural heritage", which Europeana Foundation applied with the collaboration of the DSI group.







Role of Photoconsortium: ingestion and metadata enrichment of photographic contents + coordination of the Europeana thematic page








Aggregation of new content to Europeana - from KU Leuven's collection

Work in WEAVE



Europeana aggregation project focused on intangible heritage.

It includes a huge part of work on capacity building and community curated cultural heritage. The project also develops a number of technical tools to be integrated in Europeana, editorials, and a virtual exhibition about Roma cultural heritage.

Role of Photoconsortium is mainly in coordination of the aggregation of new contents in Europeana, including 3D (!)

- CRDI: photographs and videos of Castellers and a collection of daguerreotypes digitized high quality in 3D
- TopFoto: heritage photographs on various themes
- Sounds, videos, images, 3D models of built heritage from other partners

Final conference of the project is hosted by CRDI in Girona on 16 September 2022 (hybrid event).
