






## **Data Space**

- Future work will be more focused on reuse of collections





#### City of Bruges publishes new data on Europeana.eu

In late 2023, City Archives of Bruges published over 1,000 photographs of late 19th century Bruges on Europeana.eu. They share the steps they took to make this heritage collection available and reusable.



Since the end of November 2023, visitors to Europeana.eu have been able to explore nostalgic black and white images of Bruges, the city that Georges Rodenbach described in his famous 1892 novel Bruges-la-Morte. They include well-known buildings such as the Belfry, St. John's Hospital and the city gates, but also iconic buildings that have since been demolished (such as Bruges' first railway stations). The women at the fish market, the people posing in front of their houses, the soldiers at their barracks,

## EUreka3D-XR: a new project in negotiation

- Grant Agreement expected to be signed in September
   2024. Project expected to start on 1/1/2025
- Based on the outcomes of EUreka3D with expansion of activities in the XR realm, to provide reuse of 3D digitized CH collections
- Development of new tools
- Creation of 3 pilot scenarios onsite (Girona, Bibracte, Cyprus)
- EU funding 50% (50% co-financing by the Association)
- Our role: project coordination, coordination of the reuse scenarios, impact assessment

In November, it will be 10 years since we met in Bratislava to officially found PHOTOCONSORTIUM!

To celebrate the anniversary, our President David and former President Fred propose to create a photographic book. It may focus on **street photography**, mixing heritage contents with photographs from family album, withing a nice participatory initiative.





## **About new proposals**

Calls under Horizon Europe, funded 100%, are very competitive and thus difficult to win even with excellent consortia and high-quality proposals

Calls from DEP are more specialistic, but unfortunately the co-funding rate is challenging (75% EUreka3D and 50% EUreka3D-XR)

Also the proposal just being submitted for the 3D Competence Center, with a budget of 6 millions in 3 years, is funded 50%.

Such high co-funding rates create an issue of financial sustainability (in addition to a critical cashflow because DEP foresees a 50% prefinancing and the rest comes many months after the project has finished).

We propose to appoint to the Executive Council a task for identifying possible models that can to help the Association operate in such context.
