Venue	Inhabitants	Target group
Amsterdam	850,000	Disenfranchised communities from «bad» neighbourhood, particularly women
Budapest	1,800,000	Students and their families from small towns, distant from the capital city
Sofia	1,270,000	Hearing impaired youngsters and seniors
Hämeenlinna	68,000	Ex prisoners and ex guards and inmates of the hosting Prison Museum
Krakow	765,000	High school students who do not go to museums and their grandparents
Basel	171,000	Migrant communities established in the country
Vilnius	540,000	Art students from Naujoji Vilnia district and ethnic minority groups
Pisa	90,000	Senior Pisa citizens who lived along the Arno, before, during and after the II WW

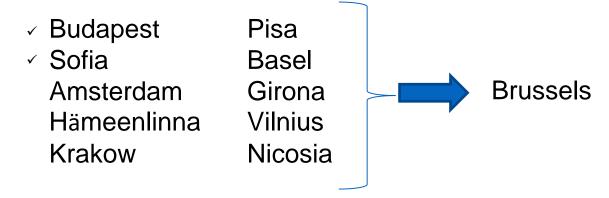


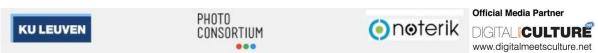

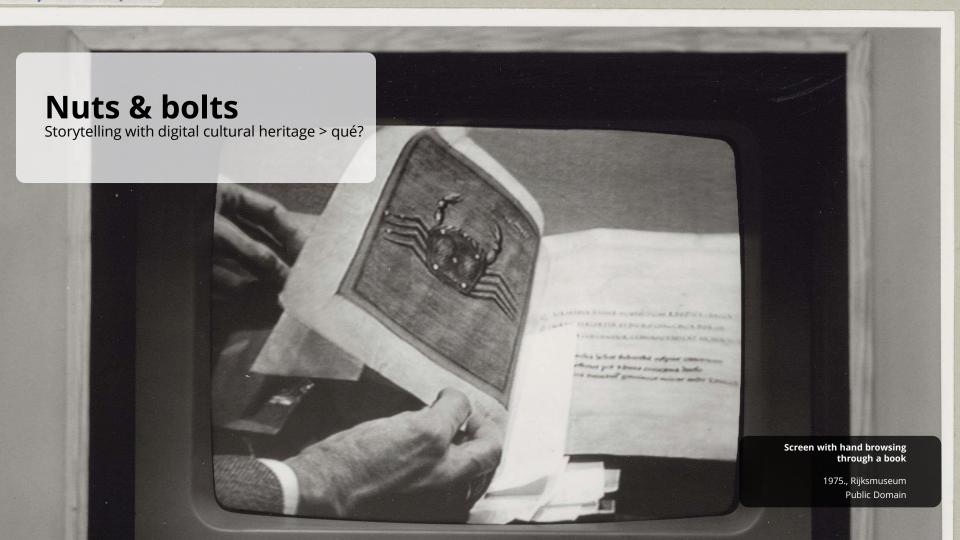


# 50s in Europe – Kaleidoscope & storytelling
