








Objectives

We want to capture the **visual identity of the Fifties** in East and Western Europe as
it was established through photography

We are looking for stereotypical concepts that can be translated in an algorithmic definition

For this, we gathered collections of sample photographs from our photography partners as well as connaisseurs

We tried to detect similarities and grouped images in sets

These sets are now trained with deep learning algorithms
