

RUNNING PROJECTS IN 2022



DSI-4 and Data Space

DSI-4 was a 4 years project: started in September 2019, concluded 31 August 2022. It is now followed by the Data Space for Cultural Heritage project (2 years, until 31 August 2024).



Activities in the **Data Space** continue similarly to DSI-4, with a bigger focus on 3D and capacity building:

- Content and metadata cleaning and improvement
- Participation in meetings and working groups, networking with other aggregators
- Capacity building event on 3D in Pisa and online 24/1/2023
- Collaboration with Euroclio/Historiana (online workshop + e-learning activities)
- Publication of blogs and galleries with a focus on tourism (collaboration with INCULTUM and participation in the winter school of USI)



- **Communications and marketing**: explore the possibility for cooperation to plan, design and implement communications campaigns in an international and regional level




A GEP Gender Equality Plan was realized in March 2023 and published on Photoconsortium's website.
